What's New with BluesEd?

We're BACK!! BluesEd is celebrating their 20th Season this spring after taking the previous summer off due to the pandemic. We currently have 30 musicians in four bands that attended our first (and hopefully last!) Virtual Kick Off Meeting. We greatly missed the annual photo opportunity but everyone was so excited by the prospect of performing again, that nobody seemed to mind!

This year, the bands range in size from 5 to 10 musicians and we welcomed 13 new members over the last 2 years. We offered all seniors from the 2019/2020 cohort the opportunity to extend their eligibility for one year due to the cancellation of last season. Our decrease from six bands to four was largely due to attrition and lingering covid concerns.

The bands have begun rehearsing for the upcoming season using current CDC social distancing guidelines while wearing masks in well-ventilated areas. It's an exciting time for getting to know our new musicians and putting together new set lists. We're excited once again to be working closely with BSO on venues and performance opportunities during the spring and summer months. There is no other youth musical development program like this in the world that is dedicated to "Keeping The Blues Alive".

Josh Hoyer and Soul Colossal CD Release Parties!

Night after night at their live shows, Josh Hoyer & Soul Colossal leave it all on the table, bringing crowds palpably authentic music. This is a real working band; music for the people, by the people. You hear the veracity in Hoyer's voice. You hear the strife of a guitar amp being pushed to its limits. You hear keyboards hammering notes home while emboldened horns soar over the top of a rhythm section akin to a freight train. The raucous funk and smooth soul emanating from the stage dutifully pays homage to the past soul giants while simultaneously charging forward, piloting themselves into the modern era. This is soul music.

Hoyer formed Josh Hoyer & Soul Colossal in 2012 in famed blues town Lincoln, Nebraska. The award-winning five-

piece band includes some of the area's most revered and accomplished musicians. Joining Hoyer (keyboards/vocals) is Blake DeForest (trumpet), Mike Keeling (bass), Benjamin Kushner (guitar), and Harrison ElDorado (drums). Inspired by the sounds of Stax, Motown, Muscle Shoals, New Orleans, Philly and San Francisco, the band continuously crosses musical boundaries both in style and era, and joins forces each show with a common goal – to have the crowd dancing so much they forget even their smallest troubles.

On March 26, 2020, Josh Hoyer & Soul Colossal released Natural Born Hustler, their 5th studio album and first album with new label partner, Color Red. The album was recorded in May and November of 2019 at Color Red studio in Denver, CO. Natural Born Hustler was recorded and produced by Color Red co-owner and guitarist of The New Mastersounds, Eddie Roberts. The pairing of Roberts and Hoyer turned out to be a perfect union of sound and writing and the band has finally captured the realness of their live shows with

Color Red. Recorded straight to tape with minimal overdubbing, the album is all about Soul and Vibe. Available worldwide in record stores, on CD and Vinyl, and on all streaming platforms, the album has recieved rave reviews internationally including American Songwriter, saying "fans of the retro music associated with the Daptone and Coalmine labels will gravitate to this...Josh Hoyer & Soul Colossal perfected their approach on stage where it counts, infusing these performances with an electrifying, pulse pounding and well, colossal presence."

Born in 1958, the son of famed blues harmonica player Carey Bell, Lurrie Bell picked up his father's guitar at age of five and taught himself to play. He was clearly gifted. In addition, he grew up with many of the Chicago blues legends around him. Eddie Taylor, Big Walter Horton, Eddie C. Campbell, Eddie Clearwater, Lovie Lee, Sunnyland Slim, Jimmy Dawkins and many more were frequent visitors to his house. They all helped to shape and

school him in the blues, but none as much as his father's long-time employer Muddy Waters.

By seventeen Lurrie Bell was playing on stage with Willie Dixon. In 1977 he was a founding member of The Sons of Blues with Freddie Dixon (son of Willie) and Billy Branch. The band recorded three standout tracks for Alligator Records' Grammy nominated Living Chicago Blues series. In 1978 Bell joined Koko Taylor's band and stayed for several years, honing his chops and learning the ropes of being a traveling musician. He continued to work with his dad

as well, recording the 1984 Rooster Blues album Son Of a Gun and several other titles for UK's JSP Records. Not only was Bell recognized as an exceptionally talented guitarist and musician, his knowledge of different blues styles, his soulfulness and his musical maturity delivered write-ups in publications such as Rolling Stone and The New York Times.

Battling and defeating a series of personal demons kept him out of the studio and off the road for a long spell in the late 1980's, but Bell persevered and re-surfaced in the mid-1990's with a succession of four highly acclaimed records for Chicago's Delmark label.

Since the onset of the new millennium, Bell's profile has been steadily rising. 2002 saw the release of the CD Cutting Heads and in 2004 Alligator Records released Second Nature an acoustic duet record with his father Carey Bell that was nominated for a WC Handy Award Acoustic Record of the Year by the Blues Foundation in Memphis.

At last count Lurrie Bell has now appeared on over 50+ recordings either as leader or featured sideman. Lurrie Bell's elegant and intense guitar playing and passionate vocals have made him a favorite at clubs and festivals around the world and have earned him a reputation as one of the "leading lights" in the future of the blues.

It wasn't until 2015 that Nicole set out on her own with over a decade of touring experience in her purse with the release of "Wolf Den" recorded in New Orleans with Anders Osborne.

Nicole's 2017 release of "Cry No More" ushered in not only a heavier sound and style differentiating Nicole's already broadening voice and writing, but also accrued a slew of accolades including a 2019 Grammy Nomination for Contemporary Blues Album; 2 Blues Music Awards for Contemporary Female Artist and her second Instrumentalist ~ Bass, and 3 Independent Blue Music Awards.

The Rex Granite Band featuring Sarah Benck was the Blues Society of Omaha's winner in the Nebraska Blues Challenge band category in 2020. The 4 piece band made it all the way to the semi-finals in Memphis at the International Blues Challenge.

BluesEd began in 2001 by the Blues Society of Omaha and was created to provide opportunities for talented Middle and High School age musicians to play with other students in a performing band format. Now boasting over 200 alumni the program continues to strive to "Keeping the Blues Alive."




