

David Graham has become known as one of Nashville's can't miss live entertainers over the past 8 years as frontman of the Eskimo Brothers. The honky tonk trio has honed their stage show and sound from nearly 300 shows per year and thousands of gig hours in the Music City honky tonks in a variation of high energy ensembles. When not playing their usual residencies in Nashville and Memphis, David has a steady lineup that tours throughout the United States. Mark Robertson (Legendary Shack Shakers) carries upright and electric bass duties and newcomer Kevin Finn (Casey James Prestwood) lends his talents behind the drum kit.

Graham was born in St. Louis, MO. When he was very young, he began performing for family – or anyone that would listen – playing and singing Elvis and Glen Camp-

bell songs with a plastic, toy guitar.

At 5 years old, his family moved to a small town in Portland, OR, where a family friend taught him how to play "Heartbreak Hotel" by Elvis. David caught on quickly, and not long after that, his parents bought him his first electric guitar. From that moment on, any hope of a conventional life or job went straight out the window. "I did not choose this life, or career, it chose me," David says.

At 15, David's dad snuck him into a rough, dive honky-tonk, where he played his first professional gig. He spent his early years playing rock, punk,and blues before being called to country music, after hearing "Ramblin Fever" by Merle Haggard. Since then, he has played thousands of shows across the country and in Europe.

David's goals are simple: to be the biggest and best male entertainer he can, and to write and perform songs that are real. David's Influences include: Hank Williams, Merle Haggard, The Stones, Willie Nelson, Waylon Jennings, The Band, Johnny Cash, Hank Jr., Ray Price, KISS, Garth Brooks, Elvis, Bob Seger, Bob Dylan, Aerosmith, Rod Stewart, Roger Miller, George Strait, AC/DC, Aretha Franklin, Frank Sinatra.

The band's signature raw and rowdy delivery of American Roots music appeals to a wide audience, and much of it can be attributed to their own vast influences. Every original song has qualities that are essential to a Country melody and content, but played with the attitude that draws a Rock fan to a genre that they would usually not listen to. Too Rock N' Roll for Country – Too Country for Rock N' Roll – Having too much fun to care.



At 33 years old, Jose Ramirez is currently Latin America's most popular blues star and has played with some of the biggest names in the blues industry. These artists include Buddy Guy, Anson Funderburgh, Janiva Magness, Mark Hummel and Bryan Lee, to name a few.

Jose recently signed a contract with

world famous blues label Delmark Records in Chicago for the release of his second studio album. This makes him the first-ever Latin-American to ever sign with the renowned record company.

Jose was recently nominated for a Blues Music Award 2021 for his debut album "Here I Come." It was produced by blues guitar legend Anson Funderburgh.

The Jose Ramirez Band recently won second place at The Blues Foundation 2020 International Blues Challenge in Memphis. The band performed in the finals at the Orpheum Theater in Memphis after advancing to the quarter and semi-finals against over 230 bands from around the world.

In the past couple of years, Jose has traveled the world playing the blues. His two European tours included more than 45 concerts in England, Spain, the Netherlands and





Belgium. His U.S.A. tour included shows around the Midwest and the South. Highlights included shows at legendary clubs such as Buddy Guy's Legends, where Buddy Guy himself joined Jose on stage.

Jose's debut album "Here I Come" was recorded in Austin, Texas under the production of blues guitar legend An-

son Funderburgh. It was mixed by Grammy Award Winner Stuart Sullivan (Jimmie Vaughan, Willie Nelson, Sublime).

Bruce Katz is a four time nominee for the Blues Music Award (W.C. Handy Award) for "Pinetop Perkins Piano Player of the Year", selected by the Blues Foundation of Memphis, TN.

While Blues is a very important part of his music, Bruce's music has more angles and influences, occupying a unique space where blues, "soul-jazz", jam-band rock, and all aspects of Americana Music collide into a style of original music all his own. He is equally comfortable playing Hammond B-3 Organ and Piano.

Besides leading the Bruce Katz Band, Bruce has performed with the Delbert McClinton Band, Jaimoe's Jasssz Band, John Hammond, and other artists as well. He was a member of the Gregg Allman Band from 2007–2013.

As a performer, Bruce has been an in-demand sideman as well as leading his own band. He has played and recorded with many of the leading names in blues and roots music, appearing on over 70 albums with artists such as Ronnie Earl, John Hammond, Delbert McClinton, Gregg Allman, Duke Robillard, Joe Louis Walker, Little Milton, Maria Muldaur, Jimmy Witherspoon, Paul Rishell, Mighty Sam McClain, Debbie Davies, David "Fathead" Newman and many others.

Bruce has a lengthy background in classical piano. After hearing a Bessie Smith record when he was 10-years-old, he started teaching himself blues and early jazz on the piano. He then heard boogie-woogie and swing music and

continued his musical journey into more aspects of jazz and American roots music. Bruce attended Berklee College of Music in the mid-1970s, studying Composition and performance.

Katz describes his music as "soul-jazz" and "jam-rock," which covers a lot of bases.

JEREMIAH JOHNSON BAND

Thursday, March 17th @ 6 pm (\$10) • Stocks n Bonds, Omaha



Born and raised in St. Louis, Jeremiah Johnson is the voice of Mississippi River blues blending with the struggles of everyday life. He began learning guitar at age 6, drawing inspiration from his rich St. Louis blues heritage and legendary guitarists, like Alvin Lee, Eric Clapton and Hank Williams Sr. and Jr. With these influences,

Johnson began building his musical foundation.

After relocating to Houston, TX, in 1999, Johnson finished in first place for three consecutive years at the Houston Regional Blues Challenges, sponsored by the Houston Blues Society. Johnson returned to St. Louis in 2009, and merged Texas style with STL blues to create the unique sound you hear today. The 10 years Johnson lived and performed in Texas changed his musical style in ways you can still hear in his music today.

In 2011, Johnson was the proud winner of the St. Louis Blues Society IBC Challenge and went on to the semifinals to represent St. Louis in Memphis, TN.

After signing a record deal with Ruf Records in March of 2018, Jeremiah immediately went to Texas to record his debut Ruf Records release, Straitjacket, with BMA award winning Mike Zito producing. After a European tour with Mike Zito in the Beginning of 2019 and then followed by a Northeastern USA tour with Zito again, Johnson has truly electrified a whole new audience.

Johnson released, "Heavens to Betsy", his 2nd Ruf Records Release on February 14th, 2020. Johnson started out 2020 touring with the Ruf Records Blues Caravan 2020 and separately with his band though out 2020. Then the Covid-19 Pandemic shut down the industry worldwide.



ly put him out of work. "Unemployed Highly Annoyed" is Johnson's response to the adverse situation. 2020 started the year on a high note when his Ruf Records release, "Heavens to Betsy", debuted at #3 on the Billboard Blues Album charts and soon climbed to the coveted #1 spot by April 11th.

With a #1 record and 70+ European Tour dates scheduled with the "2020 Ruf Records Blues Caravan"; Johnson was set to have a breakout year before everything came to a crashing halt. "Being forced into unemployment has been beyond frustrating. I decided to produce an album of songs inspired by the "Covid-19 Pandemic" and try to turn the roller coaster of emotions into something musical. This is truly a concept album." The final product is a first-class Blues/Roots Rock record that is packed full of stunning guitar work coupled with soulfully passionate bluesy southern vocals.

Johnson blends the sounds of the South, with Mississippi River blues and a touch of country flair.
