

The Rex Granite Band featuring Sarah Benck

Artist of the Year: Héctor Anchondo



Sarah Benck began her musical journey as a teen and has become a mainstay in the booming Omaha, Nebraska music scene for more than two decades. Benck performed as a multi-instrumentalist with several award winning Midwest bands, before fronting her own band. Sarah Benck and the Robbers, where she handled lead vocals and lead guitar. Her voice is defining and powerful, a blend of the great women of the Blues as well as the most memorable female rock icons. Her and Granite create songs about life, their spiritual journey and emotions everyone can relate to.

The slide guitar appears to be an extension of Rex Granite... each note that he coaxes from the guitar moans, cries and soars off the strings. His mysterious persona behind the dark glasses and wide brimmed hat give the band a unique visual stage presence. He is an old soul that grounds the band both musically and spiritually.



The duo are supported by a seasoned rhythm section of Dain Armbrust on bass and drummer Anton Divis. Their sound is hard to put in a box, they will fit the bill in almost any club or festival, satisfying Blues enthusiasts, older rockers and fans of the new age roots scene.

The band won the 2017 OEAA award for Omaha's Best Blues Band as well as the 2018/2020 IBC Nebraska Blues Challenge. They were semi-finalists at The International Blues Challenge in Memphis TN.

#### **HÉCTOR ANCHONDO**

For Héctor Anchondo, the third time really became the charmed one. Anchondo entered the 2020 International Blues Challenge in the solo/duo category and came away with the top prize: winning the solo/duo category. He also took home the Memphis Cigar Box Guitar Award for best guitarist in the solo/duo competition, where he performed representing the Blues Society of Omaha. It was Anchondo's third year performing at the IBC as the BSO's artist. In 2015 the Héctor Anchondo Band made the semifinals (from about 250 artists down to 50 semifinalists) and in 2016 the Héctor Anchondo Band went all the way to the finals, playing in the top eight bands chosen by judges from the week of performances.

Being a winner in the International Blues Challenge is a prestigious honor. For Anchondo, it was the culmination of over two decades of work. "Winning this feels like the reward for having stuck with music for 24 years."

The 21st season of BluesEd will officially Kick Off during our first meeting at Philly's on April 10th. 



## TOO SLIM AND THE TAILDRAGGERS

Tim "Too Slim" Langford is a monster guitarist and unabashed blues rocker whose influences run the gamut from Lightnin' Hopkins, Freddy King, Duane Allman, and Lynyrd Skynyrd to RobinTrower. He is a prolific singer/songwriter whose songs have now yielded an impressive 13 studio Too Slim and the Taildraggers albums, 2 solo albums and several live CD's all on his own Underworld Records imprint.

Too Slim and the Taildraggers are Tim "Too Slim" Langford on guitar/vocals, Zach Kasik on bass/vocals and Jeff "Shakey" Fowlkes on drums/vocals.

"High Desert Heat" is the latest giant step in the evolution of their contemporary Blues/Rock sound that has been described as "Straight Whiskey Blues with a Southern Rock Beer Chaser". High Desert Heat charted 11 times in the Billboard Top Blues Album Chart in 2018 and was nominated for Best Blues/Rock album at the 2019 Blues Music awards. High Desert Heat is also featured in heavy rotation on Sirius XM's B.B. King's Bluesville. Their Previous release "Blood Moon nominated for "Blues Rock Album of the Year" at the 2016 Blues Blast Music Awards " and was voted Blues Rock Album of the Year at the 2016 Jimi Awards. The Skyla Burrell Band is a full time, hardworking traveling blues band, known for their high-energy electric blues. Onstage and on record, they play 100% original material — singer/guitarist Skyla Burrell and co-founder/guitarist Mark Tomlinson share songwriting credits. For BLUES SCARS, their fifth album, and their first with the VizzTone label group, Skyla and the band bring their high energy style into the studio for a 15-song set of all new original material that reflects the ups and downs of life over the past few years.

Originally from Southern California, Skyla now makes her home in Southern Pennsylvania. She took to music early, ever since her grandmother sat her in front of the piano with a guitar. At age 15 she began singing with a classic soul band. Early on she was drawn to the stylings of female singers like Aretha, Linda Ronstadt and Bonnie Raitt; but as a guitarist her heroes were blues icons like B.B., Freddie and Albert King, as well as Robert Cray. As noted by the press, Skyla is more than just another pretty face with a great voice, she is an expressive and impressive guitarist too.

Co-founding guitarist Mark Tomlinson took a circuitous path to the band. Starting out as a drummer, he worked with the likes of John Lee Hooker and others before switching to guitar. Skyla and Mark formed the Skyla Burrell Band in 2004, and have been tearing it up ever since, with nearly non-stop touring across the US, Canada and Europe, (at one point securing the #1 top-booked band slot on Sonicbids), songwriting and recording. Their four previous albums— Working Girl Blues (2004), Living Day To Day (2006), Tough Luck (2008), and Real Love (2011) — have received regional, national and international airplay, and earned them a devoted following.
