### MICHAEL CHARLES AND HIS BAND

The New Lift Lounge (fka Murphy's Lounge) • 5:30pm ANOTHER PLACE ANOTHER TIME 2010 TOUR

Born in Australia with a soul full of blues, Charles did not "choose" music, music chose Michael Charles, so by age twelve MC took to the stage and to the road. Learning from the "masters" the foundation was laid solid for building his own design of blues and blues rock. With MC's wild, raw, but miraculously

controlled guitar performances, his instrument is always kept forefront and the focal point of the show.

The move to America in 1990 satisfied a long-time personal deep interest in the USA and answered a calling from the management of MC's hero, Buddy Guy, to appear at Legends. As with many decisions in his life, he made it and never looked back.

Along with the stage, Charles is no stranger to radio, television, and press. His music and remarkable life story have been the feature of many presentations. In the awards category MC has been recognized by the Grammy's electing him three years, including the 50th Grammy awards year in 2008, for numerous categories for his CD releases which to date number twenty-three.

In the present, Michael is touring extensively. 2008 took him back "home" to Australia during the Full Circle Tour. In 2009 Charles has charted thousands of mile in Canada, Australia, and the USA during his "Recall 2009 Tour" which is still in full swing.

There has been an annual Blues Festival in Washington Park in Quincy , IL for the last for sixteen years. Reasons include economic conditions, difficulties in fundraising, reduced attendance, hours of operations restrictions as well as other contributing factors. 
# Ronnie Baker Brooks Zoo Bar 11-4-07



Rick Estrin, Tommy Castro, Louisiana Red and Duke Robillard, each received four nominations. (Full nominees list below)

"Many nominators noted that narrowing each category to five was an especially difficult task this year, but I think the nominees are very reflective of the past year's releases. In this holiday season, I like to think of this as a present blues fans can open immediately," Jay Sieleman, The Blues Foundation's Executive Director said. 

# Coco Montoya The Essential Coco Montoya



Coco Montoya with Blind Pig Records has released a best of CD entitled The Essential Coco Montoya. This CD consists of songs off of Coco Montoya's first three solo recordings released by Blind Pig in the 90's (Gotta Mind To Travel, Ya Think I'd Know Better, and Just Let Go).

For those of you who have never heard of Coco Montoya here is a brief history. Coco Montoya was born in Santa Monica, California in 1951. Coco was raised in a house full of music. Although Coco enjoyed picking out notes on a guitar his instrument of choice was the drums. Fast forward a few years Coco Montoya's drum playing led to a spot in Albert Collins band. Coco Montoya played with the Albert Collins band for five years. After this he joined with John Mayall and the Bluesbreakers and played with the band for ten years, and the rest, as they say, is history.

Coco Montoya personally selected the tracks for this compilation all tracks document his post-Blues-breakers entry into the limelight and the beginning of a still running ascendency in the Blues-Rock realm.

The CD Essential Coco Montoya has 11 tracks all showcase Coco's soul-stirring vocals and fiery guitar solos. This truly confirms Coco's status as a world class guitar master and blues artist of the highest order.

The Essential Coco Montoya CD on Blind Pig Records would be a good introduction to Coco' Montoya's music. I would recommend this CD to all blues lovers.

### Samuel James For Rosa, Maeve, and Noreen

Samuel James has recorded an excellent cd of traditional delta blues that reminds one of Charlie Patton or Robert Johnson. James has a more linear writing style than traditional blues though. His lyrics often tell short stories.



James is a young man, nearing his thirtieth birthday, but with

his scratchy voice and great slide playing, he seems to be from a earlier time. When not playing slide, James plays in a finger picking style, and is also an excellent banjo, harp, and piano player.

James is giving Keb' Mo'and other young acoustic blues musicians a run for their money in a genre that is experiencing a minor resurgence. If your taste in blues leans toward the basic deep blues style of the pre-war delta, I would give this cd a try.

### DARRELL NULISH · JUST FOR YOU

I was riding with a friend who happened to be playing the "Just for You" CD by Darrell Nulish. Being a big Motown fan I was immediately attracted to the Bluesy/Soulful sound of Darrell's songs on this album. The album is comprised of six original songs, as well as a unique takes on J.J. Malone's "It's a Shame," Slim Harpo's "Just for You," and "The woman Don't Live Here Anymore" which was originally recorded in Memphis by label mate Lou Pride in the early 70's. Darrell's style is comparable to the likes of Robert Cray and Johnny Rawls with added warmth and intensity. Nulish has pulled together the likes of the current Fabulous Thunderbirds guitarist Johnny Moeller along with members of Severn's talented house band to intensive his bluesy style. My favorites (which was hard to choose) on this album are Nulish's take on "Just for You" and his original "Let a Woman be a Woman". I would recommend this album to anyone who enjoys listening to a soul-blues singer as in "yes" I would purchase it.


