His reign as King of the Blues has been as long as that of any monarch on earth. Yet B.B. King continues to wear his crown well.


At age 76, he is still light on his feet, singing and playing the blues with relentless passion.

### What's New with BluesEd?

#### New BluesEd Clinician - Matt McLarney

We are excited to welcome Matt McLarney as our newest BluesEd clinician! When he was just five years old, Matt remembers hearing the song *That's What Friends Are For* on the radio. His life was forever changed in that moment because he says that's when he knew he had discovered his life's calling.

He began taking piano lessons at age eight and believes that a strong background in keyboard provides a huge advantage for any musician (no matter what becomes your principal instrument in the end). As a young musician, Matt loved composing, the creative process, bringing life to an idea, and inventing something that didn't exist before. He has always been fascinated by the way different chords and melodies have certain emotional qualities and attitudes, but most importantly, he values the relationships he has formed through music. Matt has been playing with his band mates for more than half his life and feels they are all like family.

In 2003, Matt graduated from Berklee College of Music in Boston, Massachusetts, where he majored in songwriting and was a piano principal. Since then, he has been teaching private lessons in guitar, keyboard, and songwriting/performance and recently opened a teaching studio out of his home called Modern Method Music. He currently keeps busy playing with local bands Old Money and Satchel Grande and continues to study music independently.

Matt loves teaching young people. For him, teaching music becomes an interesting process where he can explore different ways to communicate an idea. "It is especially exciting to see a student perform when you are aware of the journey it took to get there," he adds.

Although he has only been with the BluesEd program for a few months, Matt says he is very impressed with the level of talent and dedication he has already seen in many of the students and appreciates the emphasis on interpretation of the material rather than recitation.

All of us in BluesEd are thrilled that Matt is part of our program and look forward to his mentorship in the months to come!





## Lil' Ed & The Blues Imperials JUMP START

On June 5, 2012, JUMP START, the blistering new album from Chicago blues masters Lil' Ed & The Blues Imperials, will be released. Just five days later, on June 10, the band will perform at the world famous Chicago Blues Festival before heading out on the road. Lil' Ed Williams is among the last of the current bluesmen who came directly out of Chicago's deep blues tradition. He didn't learn his craft listening to records, he learned first-hand from the greats all around him, most prominently his uncle, the great Chicago slide guitarist and blues legend, J.B. Hutto. Ed and the band -- guitarist Michael Garrett, Ed's brother James "Pookie" Young on bass and drummer Kelly Littleton -- have been together for almost 25 years. This is an amazing feat for a band in any genre, and is almost unheard of in the blues world. There is an amazing chemistry in this band that adds to the magic. Ed and Pookie have been playing together since Ed was 12



and Pookie was 10. Mike and Kelly joined a mere 24(!) years ago. You can feel their deep friendship in every note they play.

According to Alligator Records president Bruce Iglauer, "Lil' Ed & The Blues Imperials' live performances and records have earned them the love of the entire blues world; no one in the blues creates more contagious fun and puts more pure, visceral energy into making music."

For JUMP START, Ed wanted to (and did) experiment with some new grooves and

rhythms. He also wanted to present a few songs that showed the band's more serious and subtle side. Of course he also brought a batch of the shuffles and driving boogies the band is famous for. And he also covered (as he always does) a song by his Uncle J.B.. (If You Change Your Mind). Every other song on the album is a new original, ranging from wild slide workouts to the most intense of slow blues.

# Aaron Williams and the Hoodoo 10:49



In 2008 Aaron Williams and the Hoodoo were formed in Madison, Wisconsin. This is a band of younger musicians that tour the Midwest extensively, reportedly are increasing their fan base, and had the opportunity and experience of playing with many top notch blues artists. Their line up consists of

the standard rock/blues trio band (guitar, bass, & drums). However they invited a keyboard and a harmonica player to assist in cutting the CD they released in 2011 named, or should I say numbered, 10:49. This CD appears to be either from an independent label or a self-assembled project, with some assistance of The Blues Foundation. The CD has 10 songs, all but one written by the band members. The songs are generally quite rock oriented with a few in the blues vein. A few of the songs have a sound and style that sometimes remind me of Jim Suhler and Monkeybeat, George Thorogood, and even to lesser extent Led Zeppelin; not bad company. One of my favorites is the song My Turn as it is one of the most blues like and longest at a little over 6 minutes. Aaron, the guitarist, plays some good slide on several songs and a cigar box guitar on a few others. All of the band members share in the vocal duties, but I was not overly impressed with that aspect of their talents. If you like your blues with a strong rock approach you would likely enjoy this CD. The band is scheduled to appear at Harrah's Casino (Stir Live & Loud) on Friday July 21st. I expect that will be a good show.

### Pinetop Perkins *Heaven*

**Blind Pig Records** 



Pinetop Perkins died recently just shy of his 98 birthday. Pinetop spent twelve years with the Muddy Waters Band. He was self taught on the piano and is widely regarded as one of the greatest blues players of all time. He was vey active creating exceptional blues right up to his death.

Heaven was recorded in 1986, when Pinetop was only 73. All but four tracks have him performing solo. Contributions were recently added to these tracks by Willie "Big Eyes" Smith and Otis Clav.

Pinetop is in excellent form throughout this cd. Highlights include Sitting on Top of the World and the classic Pinetop's Boogie Woogie.

The vocals by Perkins have a rough authentic feel of someone that has lived the lyrics. The piano playing is more of the classic style that Pinetop is known for the world over.

I enjoyed this cd a great deal, but it is not for everyone. It is sparse and has a very old-time feel. This could be viewed as a strength by some, but I think others will be put-off.
