

Born in South St. Louis, Mo. Mike Zito grew up in a working class home with a dire love of music. It was his escape and way out. After a decade working in a local guitar shop, Mike learned his craft from the ground up playing in clubs 7 nights a week. He fell in love with the Blues of St. Louis and the stories of the country singers. His first self released album "Blue Room" hit the streets in 1998 and he has made 12 albums total over the years. He signed and recorded with Eclecto Groove Records and Ruf Records. He is a founding member of the supergroup "Royal Southern Brotherhood" with Cyril Neville and Devon Allman. In 2012 he formed his own group, The Wheel. Mike has produced albums for Samantha Fish, Laurence Jones, Albert Castiglia and others. He tours extensively in the USA, Canada and Europe. He has been honored with multiple Blues Music Awards over the past 10 years. His love of life and pursuit of happiness is felt in every note he sings and plays.

The journey began for Davy Knowles growing up in the Isle of Man, learning to play guitar from listening to the likes of Gallagher, Clapton, Knopfler, Green and Mayall in his father's record collection, and honing his skills playing the local music circuit. Knowles's professional career started with a bang — arriving in America age 19 with his band Back Door Slam, an acclaimed debut album, and rave reviews at SXSW 2007.

From that dynamic introduction, Knowles proceeded to make a significant impact across US media – from memorable TV performances on Jimmy Kimmel and Good Morning America, to a three year run at radio with the singles 'Come Home' from the debut album Roll Away and 'Tear Down the Walls' and 'Coming Up For Air' from the Peter Frampton produced sophomore album – both albums Top 3 Billboard Blues Chart.

JIMMIE BRATCHER

They call Jimmie Bratcher "The Electric Rev."

Not only because his lightning-strike performances crackle with high-voltage guitar playing and emotionally charged vocals. Or because Bratcher makes the hairs rise on the arms of the crowds he entertains in the map of clubs, festivals, bike rallies, churches and prisons that he calls "the road."

But because the ascending blues star is literally a preacher, as comfortable testifying in the pulpit about the power of Jesus as he is in smoky bars celebrating the vigor of the blues.

Bratcher's shows — regardless of location — are worry-free zones, where the healing, good-time mojo of rockin' blues sets hearts and minds, and maybe even souls, free. His latest album Secretly Famous is fueled by the same attitude. The disc's dozen tracks are packed with humor, romance, joy and the thrill of finding the same at every turn, plus some real-life reflection. And they're all buoyed by Bratcher's gravel dappled tenor voice and his gritty, muscular and deeply rooted guitar playing, supported by a versatile rhythm section of drummer Lester Estelle Jr. and bassist Craig Kew.

Throughout Secretly Famous Bratcher's songs shine a spotlight on his unique perspective. The slinky, groove-driven "57," for example, is a first — a tribute to the Shure SM-57 microphone, a staple of the stage and the studio known for its ability to capture the sound of the electric quitar.

Led by harmonica master and songwriter Pierre Lacocque, Mississippi Heat is a world-class Chicago Blues Band. Their motto is "Traditional Blues With A Unique Sound" as they present fresh yet vintage-based musical ideas.

MISSISSIPPI HEAT's name is a reflection of Pierre's reverence for Mississippi's blues culture and music. The band's conviction is that there is no deeper music than Delta-inspired blues to express what lies in everyone's soul. They have received world-wide critical acclaim, including from Living Blues Magazine: "MISSISSIPPI HEAT delivers its traditional urban blues with a freshness, energy and competence that makes them a treasure on today's Chicago scene."

Mississippi Heat is known internationally for their passionate blues delivery. Overseas and national touring have been an integral part of their work for decades. The band has appeared at many world-famous festivals including many in the US (like the Pocono's and the Chicago Blues Festivals), Scandinavia, Germany, France, Italy, Switzerland, The Netherlands, Canada, Tunisia, Finland, Venezuela and in Mexico, among many others. Besides a scheduled European tour for 2018, they will also soon perform in Dubai.

Buddy Guy has gone on record saying that it's "been a long time since I heard a good blues band like this." And recently the band received this critical acclaim from Bonnie Tallman at the Billtown Blues Festival (Hughesville, PA): "Can't find enough words to express how blown away everyone was with the Mississippi Heat performance! It was spectacular in every way."


The band has made waves on the blues charts by regularly reaching the #1 spot on Living Blues Magazine's radio charts.

Review



The Rex Granite Band featuring Sarah Benck Spirit/Matter/Truth/Lies



Nebraska Blues Challenge winner The Rex Granite Band featuring Sarah Benck has released a very good cd - not just a nice local band cd - but a very good cd period. They will be a firstrate representative of BSO at the International Blues Challenge.

The Omaha veteran musicians' rockin' blues album has nine originals and one cover. The cover is a fine version of the Percy Mayfield song "Please Send Me Someone to Love" sung emotively by Benck. The opening cut "Stop Doing What You Want" is an uptempo song that makes for a great introduction. There is some adept slide supplied by Granite. Another favorite song of mine is

the hard charging "Steamroller". It has some great horns and is guaranteed to make people want to get up and dance!

Benck sings fervently on this album. Her singing reminds me of Sue Foley at times. Foley has been a singer I have listened to for many years. Granite plays proficient slide throughout the collection. This is an excellent cd and should be picked up by people that enjoy modern blues and want to support some of the many great artists of Omaha.
